## Escape from the Fast Pace of Everyday at Rock Harbor Lodge

Isle Royale National Park, a dramatic escape from the northwest Lake Superior archipelago wilderness, is only accessible by seaplane or boat. There are no roads on the islands. Rock Harbor Lodge, MI offers the lodging (housekeeping cabins, front rooms, plus a restaurant and grill onsite). For the naturalist, fisherman and hiker, long 16-hour summer days allow extended recreational time. Ferries run seasonally from Grand Portage, MN, Houghton and Copper Harbor, MI. The seaplane operates from Houghton, MI. Open Memorial Day through mid-Sept. Lodging/transportation packages offered; all inclusive kayak eco tours offered. Groups welcome. Two camper cabins are offered at the Windigo/Washington Harbor.
